With the help of volunteers and funders, we create thriving neighborhoods for our vulnerable populations by revitalizing community spaces, enhancing schools, and creating and maintaining affordable housing. Since 1986, more than 27,000 volunteers have worked on 2,100+ projects, investing \$7.5 million worth of in-kind value into our community.

During this fall, these partners provided repairs and weatherization for nearly 20 clients, a teen center, and an elementary school, all serving low-income neighborhoods.

REINVESTING IN ALEXANDRIA

With our \$500,000 Project Reinvest grant, we have already worked on 18 homes in the Hume Springs and Lynhaven areas, the geographic concentration of these funds. We have also completed work at the Cora Kelly Elementary School and in October, held resident meetings to discuss plans for the community growing garden and the multi-generational park. With this community revitalization effort, we are trying to build more socially and economically resilient neighborhoods. Stay tuned for more updates!

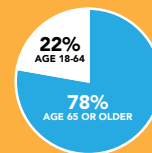
HOMEOWNERS SERVED IN FY17



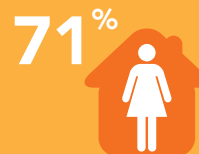
Our clients have **1.8** people living at home, with a household income of just **\$30,048**



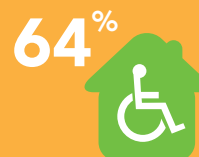
40% of clients are extremely low income, **27%** very low income, **33%** low income.
